Exploring the Bible

The Bible might look like a single book, but it is actually a library made up of 66 different books! 39 Books in the Old Testament and 27 in the New Testament.

The Old Testament books were all written before Jesus came to the earth as a baby (BC) and the New Testament books were all written afterwards (AD)

The books in the Bible are not in the order they were written; they are grovped by type of book.

The Old **Testament**

The first five books are known as the Pentateuch or Law books these tell the story from Creation through to Moses leading God's people out of slavery and into the promised land.

The rest of the Old Testament includes History books, Poetry books, sometimes known as Wisdom books and large and small books written by prophets – these are known as the Major and Minor prophets.

Finding your way around the Bible can take a bit of practice but there are lots of things to help you.

The New Testament

The first four books of the New Testament are known as the Gospels - they tell the Good News about Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

Acts tells the History of the Early Church.

Most of the New Testament is made up of Epistles (letters) written to some of the first Christians. The Bible ends with Revelation a prophetic book about Jesus' return.

> At the beginning of the Bible is a **CONTENTS** page - it lists all the books of the Bible and tells you on which page each book begins.


